**Accuracy:**

Mike Dunleavy was a strong proponent for amending the constitution to allow public funds to go to private and religious schools, which would remove funding from and further weaken our public schools. He also insisted that vague performance improvements were needed before public school funding could be raised to adequate levels. While K-12 funding was increased, it was far less than what was needed to keep last year’s levels of teaching staff in our schools into the future.
